Project Graduation 2017

Dear Senior Parents/Guardians,

Can you believe that in only a short time your student will be receiving his or her diploma? On that same note, Project Graduation is close at hand and we want to provide our seniors with a safe and fun environment to celebrate their accomplishment. Project Graduation 2017 will be held the night of graduation, May 27th from 10:000 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. on May 28th, inside Goose Creek Memorial High School.

Entry will include the following:

FOOD – Provided throughout the evening. This will consist of pizza, chips/dips, chicken nuggets, etc.

DRINKS – Unlimited amount of soda, water and coffee all night.

GAMES/ENTERTAINMENT – Scheduled activities with unlimited play will be available. Activities will possibly include volleyball, basketball, sumo wrestling, a mechanical bull, a photo booth, a hypnotist, a caricature artist, various inflatables (obstacle run, hoop shot, bungee run), etc.

We have already had numerous meetings to discuss the planning of this event and we have held several fundraisers. Most of the food and drink items are donated by local businesses, therefore the funds that have been raised will be used to pay for the entertainment and to purchase door prizes for seniors to win that night.

*Please note that in order to be eligible to win door prizes; senior students must have reached a “prize level” through their fundraising efforts (level information on following page) or pay the \$50.00 entry fee by Friday, May 12th.

Senior students who did not participate in fundraisers are eligible to attend Project Graduation, but will be required to pay an entry fee of \$50.00 by Friday, May 12th. From May 13th to May 27th the entry fee will be \$75.00 **cash per person and students will not be eligible to receive any tickets.

Donation Levels & Entry Details

GCM seniors attending Project Graduation who have met a fundraising level will receive tickets that will be used to win door prizes:

\$650 in Fundraising	Patriot Level	55 Tickets
\$325 in Fundraising	Silver Level	30 Tickets
\$ 150 in Fundraising	Red Level	15 Tickets
\$ 100 in Fundraising	Black Level	8 Tickets
No Fundraising	Pay \$50.00 by-May 12th	4 Tickets

*All senior students who reach the Patriot level are guaranteed a grand prize per level reached for their fundraising efforts.

The night of Project Graduation there will be buckets set up on tables that Seniors will place tickets in the buckets for those prizes they are interested in winning (students may place more than one ticket in each prize bucket, but may only win once from each bucket).

All GCM seniors who have reached a fundraising level that return their completed Project Graduation Contract and entry fee payment by Friday, May 12th will receive an additional 5 tickets. From Monday, May 15th – Friday May 27th, you can still turn in your contract, but you will not receive the additional 5 tickets.

*If you haven't reached a fundraising level, you aren't eligible for any additional tickets.

Each GCM senior who attends Project Graduation may bring one guest for a cost of \$25.00 (guest **cannot** be another GCM senior student). Guests will be allowed to enjoy the activities and refreshments, but will not have an opportunity to win door prizes. Guests will be required to sign the contract of the senior who invited them. Guest age limit is 21. **There will be no charge for the guest of students who reached the Patriot Level.**

For those of you who procrastinate...if you wait until the last minute (after May 13th) to decide that you want to attend, you may, but the cost will be \$75.00 per person (cash only – the cost for a guest will remain \$25.00) and you will be required to turn in a completed contract. We will also collect \$75.00 cash payment at the door the night of Project Graduation.

*The funds collected from senior students who pay at the door the night of Project Graduation will be divided among all GCM Seniors. Each Senior will receive an envelope with cash inside.
